Our partnership with DHL has been formed out of aligned interests and mutual beliefs that innovation is the catalyst behind reduced environmental impact.


SIF17 will take place inside an award-winning inflatable structure that will be powered by DHL's renewable energy with all food waste from the Forum being converted into energy.
